
Students' Welfare



Chapter-VI





6.1 Director, Students' Welfare

The Directorate of Students' Welfare, Junagadh Agricultural University is looking after various students' activities/facilities including sports, culture, fellowships, scholarships, residential, recreation, health, adventure, NSS counselling, placement, etc. Moreover, dignitaries of different fields are invited to share their thoughts, experiences and views among the staff and students.

6.2 Students' Union

In the colleges of Junagadh Agricultural University, the Students' Representative Council (SRC) is formed by the Principal of respective colleges by selecting the sincere and leading students in sports, culture, debate and adventure activities. The Principal also nominates the Chairman and staff advisors and they act as a Chairman of SRC of respective College.

6.3 Students' Facilities

All the undergraduate and post graduate students are provided with hostel facilities with an attached mess. Three new hostels *viz;* Govardhan, Vivekanand hall of residence for College of Agricultural Engineering & Technology, Girls' hostel for College of Fisheries, Veraval were constructed. A central library near to the hostel area is utilized by students for reference, reading and net surfing. A sport complex also exists near the hostels and interested students utilize the facilities acco-

rding to their choice. Moreover, a multi purpose Indoor Sports Stadium constructed at the cost of ₹ 2.38 crore will become functi-onal within a short period of time.

Students' Counselling and Placement

Director of Students' Welfare coordinates and monitors the activities of Student Counseling and Placement cells functioning in all the constituent colleges of the Junagadh Agricultural University.

The objectives of Student Counseling and Placement cell functioning under the Director, Students' Welfare is to maintain data base of the students of outgoing batch and to keep in constant touch with various employers for conducting campus interview for providing better placement. The Directorate also arranges special lectures and short term training on Personality development and life skills for the students of all the faculties so as to build the self esteem among the students and to face the challenges with confidence.

A seminar was arranged with LCD presentation by Nikitin Contractor, Baroda to provide the information for internship programme in Israel on the 8th April, 2010 which was attended by the students of Seventh semester of U.G. and all Post Graduate students of Agriculture and Agricultural Engineering & Technology faculties. Similar type of programme was also arranged for the students of Polytechnic in Horticulture and Agro Processing.



6.6 Students' Magazine




