# From the Vice Chancellor's Desk

Leveraging FPOs For Farm Profitability And Rural Prosperity

Dear Colleagues,

It is my pleasure to meet you all through this edition of the JAU newsletter, which captures glimpses of our XVIII Annual Convocation ceremony along with several activities, celebrations, and achievements. The stakeholders of Indian National Agricultural Research & Education System (NARES) are working towards enhancing the livelihood and income of small and marginal farmers. Farmer Produce Organizations (FPOs) are serving as an



important component to provide support to small farmers with end-to-end services covering almost all aspects of cultivation from inputs, technical services to processing and marketing. FPOs have become no less than a buzzword with extensive support from the central and state governments. Like cooperatives, FPOs are also pillared around the principle of 'collectivization' for reducing transaction costs and realizing scale advantages. Though the origins of cooperatives date back to the early 19th century in India, it was only the late Prof. Y. K. Alagh, Gujarat-based educationist par farm economist, under whose chairmanship the concept of FPOs was promulgated by bringing together the desirable aspects of cooperative and corporate sectors. It is beyond doubt that cooperatives have played a stellar role in ensuring agricultural growth and prosperity. But, given the right kind of management, FPOs have the potential to outperform cooperatives themselves. As of 2021-22, there are more than 7500 registered FPOs in the country. It is inspiring to see such a good number. But more than 50% of the entities are concentrated in only four states and, that too, in some districts like Pune leading the nation with 180-plus FPOs. On the other hand, there are 35 districts with farmers' population exceeding one lakh but without a single functional FPO. To address this regional imbalance, the Government of India launched a central sector scheme called 'Formation and promotion of 10,000 FPOs by 2027-28' with a budgetary provision of Rs. 6,865 crores. NABARD also proposed a dedicated credit guarantee fund of Rs. 1000 crore for establishing 10,000 FPOs besides the already existing Producers Organization Development Fund (PODF). JAU recommended the following action strategies for improving the functionality of FPOs in Gujarat, which have a nationwide appeal as well: 1) Extension of tax exemption to FPOs on par with cooperatives; 2) Incentivizing FPOs for the creation and maintenance of rural farm infrastructure; 3) Extending External Commercial Borrowings (ECBs) on par with NGOs and NBFCs; 4) Promoting group insurance schemes for FPO member farmers, and 5) Provision of collateral free loans up to Rs. 25 lakhs for FPOs FPOs may have the potential to emerge as a game-changer in making farming a more viable proposition provided the existing institutional support and handholding continue for at least another decade and, simultaneously, the entities continue to be independently and professionally managed. We, as agricultural universities, also have the mandate to keep upskilling our students in tune with the current market needs, which ultimately will lead to the upliftment of FPOs and the betterment of farmers.
